At Alaknanda's Mandakini Enclave fully grown trees were cut without any prior permission. A fine of Rs 60,000 per tree can be imposed for illegal cutting or felling of trees, Rs 20,000 for illegal pruning/headbacking of trees, and Rs 10,000 for every tree found concretized around its base.

for tion veller Tree felling in Alaknanda: Forest dept notice to SDMC

New Delhi: After an environmental activist flagged violations at Alaknanda's Mandakini Enclave on Thursday, stating fully grown trees had been cut on the premises without any prior permission, the Delhi forest and wildlife department has issued a notice to South Delhi Municipal Corporation, the land-owning agency.

Forest officials say while an initial inspection had found two trees that were felled, the numbers may be higher. A

and two jaitni trees. "The trees are likely to have been cut during the lockdown period and we have recently noticed a number of trees to be missing," said a local resident on condition of anonymity. The Mandakini Enclave RWA refused to comment on the matter.

DCP (South) Anshu Anand said TOI there was no permission to cut or prune trees. "We have issued a notice to the south corporation, which is the land-owning agency. During our first inspection, we identified two trees, which were felled."

Govt grants permission for cutting, transplantation of over 1,500 trees

The Delhi government gave permission for cutting or transplantation of 1,639 trees for redevelopment of General Pool Residential Accommodation (GPRA) at Netaji Nagar. Of these trees, 325 trees will be felled and 1,314 will be transplanted, as per a notification issued by the Delhi government. The project is part of the redevelopment of seven government colonies in the city.

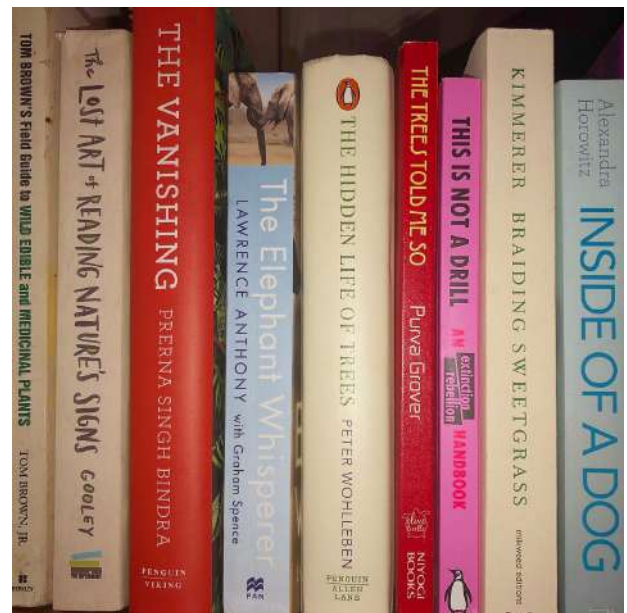

De-Choke Trees

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 23rd April 2013 has directed all Public Authorities to ensure that all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signage's, electric wires and high tension cables or otherwise are removed from the trees.

They shall also ensure that the concrete surrounding the trees within one meter of the trees are removed and all the trees are looked after well and due precaution is taken in future so that no concrete or construction or repairing work is done at least within one meter radius of the trunk of trees.

WHAT TO DO IF A TREE IS BEING CUT ?

- Click pictures
- Tell them to stop immediately
- Ask them to show the Forest Department permission.
- No permission, then Call 100 and wait till help arrives.
- Write a letter to the Forest Department
- If they have permission, check the terms and conditions section, take the tree officers details who must be present there and contact the Forest Department .
