

South district cops to be sensitised regarding tree preservation act

A notice has been issued to sensitize the south district to sensitize police officers regarding the

Delhi Preservation Of Trees Act.

South dist cops to be sensitised about tree preservation Act

New Delhi: A notice has been issued to all assistant commissioners of police and station house officers in the south district to sensitise police officers regarding the rules of Delhi Preservation of Trees Act, 1994. The notice also asked the staff to consult their seniors if there is any confusion over the law.

This was told to Delhi High Court as part of a submission made by police in a case where they were called in to stop the ongoing work, during which several trees had allegedly been damaged.

Inspections carried out later by the forest and wildlife department had found that the roots of 30 trees had been damaged due to work being carried out on the stretch, with Public Works Department (PWD) not

leaving adequate space between the trees and the area being dug up.

"The official only verified the credentials of PWD staff and did not stop the work immediately under a mistaken belief that such work was authorisedly being undertaken. The said mistake was as a result of ignorance and it was not wilful or deliberate disobedience of the law," said the submission, which added that notices to create awareness were now being circulated across all police stations in the south district to avoid

such an incident in the future.

"All ACPs/SHOs of the south district are hereby directed to brief and sensitise all the staff posted under their supervision about the provisions of the Delhi Preservation of Trees Act, 1994. The staff may also be advised to consult their seniors in case they have any confusion about the related agency/department which is required to be intimated in a particular complaint, where necessary action has to be taken by them," sald the notice issued to all police stations.

In September 2020, PWD was fined Rs 4 lakh for damaging around 30 trees along Meera Marg while carrying out construction and digging work. Activist Verhaen Khanna had filed a police complaint, alleging damage to roots and a violation of a 2013 NGT order which prohibits concretisation around a 6-feet radius of trees.

Cure "tree blindness"

देश में हर दिन ओस्तान 8,300 पेड़ किसी न किसी बजह से कट जाते हैं। लोगों को नहीं पता होता कि पेड़ों को बचाने के लिए क्या किया जाए। पेड़ों के संरक्षण में जुड़ी जानकारी एक जगह नहीं गिल पाती। दिल्ली के विरोत खना पेड़ों की सारी जानकारी एकसाथ इकट्ठा करके सेव ट्रीड एप बना रहे हैं। 32 साल के विरोत नई दिल्ली नेवर सीसायटी (एनडीएनएस) चलाते हैं। यह अब तब हजारी शहर के स्वार में स्वार को हैं।

अवनार (एनअएनएस) नवात हा अब अब तैब हजारों पेख्नें को कटने से बचा चुके हैं। विरान लोगों की 'टी-ब्लाइंडनेस' दूर करने में भी मदद करते हैं। वे पूछते हैं कि हममें से कितने लोगों वीन पर पेड़ों को देखकर उहरती है? कितने लोग दफ्तर के रास्ते में अगेने वाले पेड़ों पर गौर करते हैं। या उन्हें पेड़-पौधों का नाम चद रह पता है? लोग पेड़-पौधों को अमूमन नजरअंदाज कर देते हैं। उन्हें पता तक नहीं चरता कि कब उनके आसपड़ोस, बाग-बगींचे में लगा पेड़' विकास' की भीट चढ़ गथा। वे भी एक तरह का अंधापन है, इसे 'ट्रो ब्लाइंडनेस' कहते हैं।

विरेन बवाते हैं कि सिर्फ दिल्ली ही नहीं अधिकांश शहर वंज्जीट के जंगल हो चुके हैं। बच्चों के साथ-साथ वयस्कों तक को पेड़ों के नाम नहीं पता। कई बच्चे तो ऐसे हैं, जिन्होंने पेड़ छूकर तक पेड़ों को होर्डिंग व क्युआर कोड से बचाने की जंग



विरेन के पास कमशियल प्रयानेट लाइसेंस है। पेड़ की जाड़ों के आसपास बने सीमेंट के चब्रुवरे, फुटपाथ आदि को तीड़ने के लिए भी वे कोर्ट केसेंस लड़ रहे हैं। इसके अलावा पेड़ों पर लगे विज्ञापन, होर्डिंग और क्युआरकोड़ संच्यारें के लिए भी वे संचयरत हैं।

नहीं देखे। विरेन ऐसे लोगों को हर सप्ताह दिल्ली में नेनर वॉक पर ले जाते हैं। स्कूल-कॉलेज के बच्चों से पेड़-पीधों पर चर्चा करते हैं। वे सबकों पेड़ों को रुपशं करते, उन्हें गले लागने के लिए प्रेरित करते हैं। वे कहते हैं कि इससे न सिर्फ पेड़ों से एक एशा कावम होता है, बद्धित ट्री ब्लाईडनेस भी दूर होती है। वे बच्चों को पेड़ों पर सुर्वश्रत तरीके से चढ़ना भी सिखाते हैं।

बिरेन ने 2014 में एनडीएनएस की शुरुआत को थी। पहले उन्हें भी ट्री-ब्लाइंडिनेस थी। इसके बाद उन्होंने प्रकृति के बीच बबत बिताना लोगों को जागरूक करना शुरू किया। शुरुआत फेसबुक पेज से की। इसके बाद सोशल मीडिया के साथ-साथ स्कृत-कॉलेज में बार्यक्रम आयोजित करना शुरू किए। लेकिन अब उनके अधिका जगरूकता कार्यक्रम पेड़-पीथों के बीच होते हैं।



De-Choke Trees

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 23rd April 2013 has directed all Public Authorities to ensure that all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signage's, electric wires and high tension cables or otherwise are removed from the trees.

They shall also ensure that the concrete surrounding the trees within one meter of the trees are removed and all the trees are looked after well and due precaution is taken in future so that no concrete or construction or repairing work is done at least within one meter radius of the trunk of trees.

- -Click pictures
- -Tell them to stop immediately
- -Ask them to show the Forest Department permission.
- -No permission, then Call 100 and wait till help arrives.
- -Write a letter to the Forest Department
- -If they have permission, take the supervisors details who must be present there and contact the Forest Department .
