NDNS Needs Your Help

New Delhi Nature Society has helped to save numerous trees and animals across the capital over the years. Every day we get calls from different parts of the city, where people request us for assistance. Animals need to be rescued, trees need to be saved, and we have to attend meetings to revive water bodies and survey biodiversity parks, etc. We need to conduct site inspections regularly. A lot of our fieldwork is directly related to our litigation for environment conservation. For all this work we need to have a mode of conveyance, and sometimes we are left helpless and stranded since our organization does not own any vehicle at the moment.

We are reaching out to all our supporters for some help to get our first vehicle. So, if you can help us with an old vehicle which is in good working condition, or help us to raise funds to buy a new vehicle, then it would greatly help in our work. We require a large vehicle which will be very helpful to travel with animals, also it can be helpful to save a fallen tree. We require an SUV so that we can access all terrains in and around the city.

If we get a single donor, their name / donating company name will be printed on the sides of the vehicle. De-Choke Trees

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 23rd April 2013 has directed all Public Authorities to ensure that all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signage's, electric wires and high tension cables or otherwise are removed from the trees.

They shall also ensure that the concrete surrounding the trees within one meter of the trees are removed and all the trees are looked after well and due precaution is taken in future so that no concrete or construction or repairing work is done at least within one meter radius of the trunk of trees.

- -Click pictures
- -Tell them to stop immediately
- show -Ask them to the Forest Department permission.
- -No permission, then Call 100 and wait till help arrives.
- -Report the matter on the Green Helpline
- -1800118600
- -Write a letter to the Forest Department
- -If they do have permission, then take the supervisor's details who must be present there and contact the Forest Department.
