Afternoons with Annie-Radio One 94.3 FM



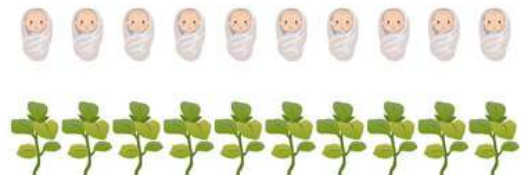

Compensatory Plantation



Some people believe that if you chop down a full grown large size tree, it can be compensated by planting 10 small saplings.

But is it really compensated ?
Lets discuss!

When you remove one large full grown tree and you plant 10 tiny saplings :-

1. The protected wildlife species living on and inside the full grown tree, are disturbed and also killed in some cases. (Wildlife Protection Act 1972: Disturbing a nest = hunting)
2. Nobody can stand under the sapling for shade like they stand under the tree.
3. Nobody can climb the saplings like they used to climb the tree.
4. The same birds and squirrels which were living on the full grown tree can not live on the sapling.
5. It will take 30 years for the saplings to reach the size of the 30 year old tree.

When you remove a 30 year old man and replace him with 10 infants :-

1. The infants can not complete the same tasks as the 30 year old man.
2. It will take 30 years for the infants to reach the same level of skills as a 30 year old man.

When plantation sites were checked, at some places it was found that no saplings were planted there in the first place, sites where saplings were actually planted - majority didn't survive. And now the authorities say that there is no place for any more compensatory plantation, so you can destroy a tree here, and plant 10 saplings in other states and pretend that everything is compensated. At this rate, soon, compensatory plantation will be done on the moon.

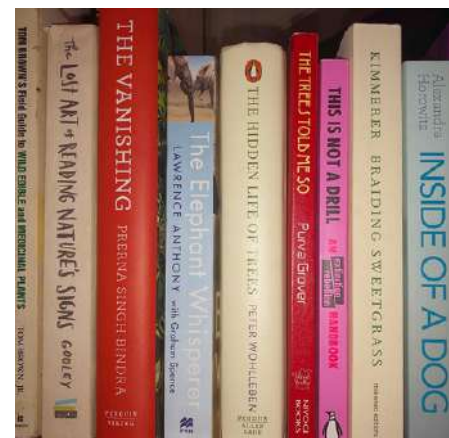

De-Choke Trees

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 23rd April 2013 has directed all Public Authorities to ensure that all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signage's, electric wires and high tension cables or otherwise are removed from the trees.

They shall also ensure that the concrete surrounding the trees within one meter of the trees are removed and all the trees are looked after well and due precaution is taken in future so that no concrete or construction or repairing work is done at least within one meter radius of the trunk of trees.

- If they do have permission, then take the supervisor's details who must be present there and contact the Forest Department .

बूँद बूँद से सागर भरता है

When a tree had fallen, due to concretization and construction within 1m of the tree trunk, the authorities refused to help to save the tree. But thanks to your kind support, we were able to hire a crane, workers, a truck full of mud, and several hours of our team efforts to save the tree. Several years later that tree is still standing alive, healthy, and strong. So, if it wasn't for your help, that living being would have been chopped and thrown away like a non-living object. Today, people wait under that tree for their bus just to commute daily, a food vendor and locksmith have also started their business under the same tree, they didn't want to work daily under the direct sunlight.

People like you are the only reason NDNS could save so many trees and animals over the years. Without your help, we would not be able to conduct awareness workshops in schools and colleges across the city.

We need to raise funds for saving more trees and animals this year. For this, we need to hire a team of trained people who will be able to do a great job in the field. We need to hire professional in-office staff to improve coordination between departments and to follow up on pending cases. We need to buy necessary equipment, first-aid, food for animals, tools for safety, communication devices, stationary et al. to improve our daily functioning. The head office requires expansion and we need a vehicle to be able to travel quickly in emergencies. So our goal for this fundraiser is Rs. 50 Lakh. This amount will cover a great share of the expenses mentioned above.

Your support is key to helping the community and the environment.

Rs, 5,000/- = Save 1 fallen tree (8-10 trees per year requirement = Rs 50,000)

Rs 5,000/- = Hire 1 intern for 1 month (4 per month x 1 year requirement = Rs. 2,40,000)

Rs 30,000/- = First-aid and safety equipment

Rs 30,000/- = Monthly salary for 1 permanent team member (5-6 required = Rs 18,00,000)

Rs 50,000/- = Food for rescued birds

Rs 50,000/- = Flyers for helping animals, trees, birds card game, board game et al.

Rs 50,000/- = 1 laptop/computer (3 required = Rs 1,50,000)

Rs 1,50,000/- = Travel, stationary, communications, awareness promotion, uniforms et al.

Rs 6,00,000/- = 1 year office space

Rs 10,00,000/- = Official emergency vehicle
