## Modern Waste Management

"Waste management in India is a complex challenge due to the country's substantial population and diverse waste streams. The generation of solid waste, including household, industrial, and biomedical waste, is significant, exacerbated by rapid urbanization. The collection and transportation of waste by municipalities are a challenge, especially in densely populated areas. Segregation at the source is essential but not widely practiced, leading to mixed waste. India has a growing informal recycling sector, but formal recycling infrastructure and regulations need improvement. Disposal historically involved open dumps, causing environmental pollution, though eco-conscious younger people are making changes in their lifestyle and composting at home, but more people need to get on board and the sooner the better. Waste-to-energy plants are emerging to generate electricity by burning the garbage, so indirectly the garbage is being stored within the citizens' lungs. A recent article highlighted that Delhiites are losing 12 years of their lives due to air pollution. Government regulations, such as the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, emphasize source segregation and extended producer responsibility. Challenges include inadequate infrastructure, awareness, and funding. Public engagement and innovative initiatives play vital roles in advancing sustainable waste management in India," explained Environmental activist Verhaen Khanna.

Adding on to this, he emphasized on the woes of the NGO's who don't get any support from the government. "Government intervention plays a pivotal role in surmounting these obstacles. By providing funding, updating and enforcing waste management policies, investing in infrastructure, and conducting public awareness campaigns, governments can significantly bolster the efforts of NGOs. Furthermore, collaborative partnerships between NGOs and government entities can foster innovation, making way for advanced technologies and sustainable practices in waste management. Advocacy efforts can also be more potent with government support, as policy changes and legislation can reinforce the push for responsible waste management. By bridging the gap between NGOs and government bodies, it becomes possible to work together effectively, thereby contributing to a more sustainable and environmentally responsible future," states the activist.

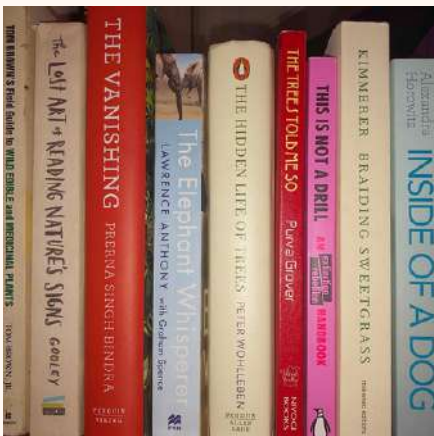

### De-Choke Trees

The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 23rd April 2013 has directed all Public Authorities to ensure that all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signage's, electric wires and high tension cables or otherwise are removed from the trees.

They shall also ensure that the concrete surrounding the trees within one meter of the trees are removed and all the trees are looked after well and due precaution is taken in future so that no concrete or construction or repairing work is done at least within one meter radius of the trunk of trees.

- Ask them to show the Forest Department permission.
- No permission, then Call 100 and wait till help arrives.
- Report the matter on the Green Helpline 1800118600
- Write a letter to the Forest Department
- If they do have permission, then take the supervisor's details who must be present there and contact the Forest Department .
